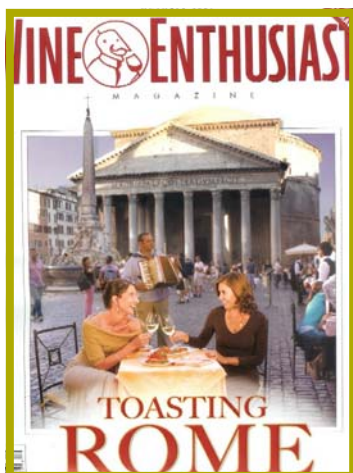

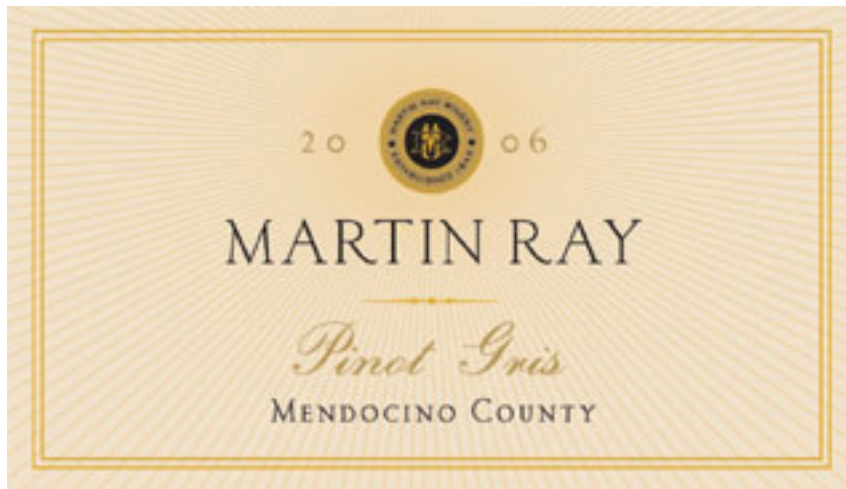

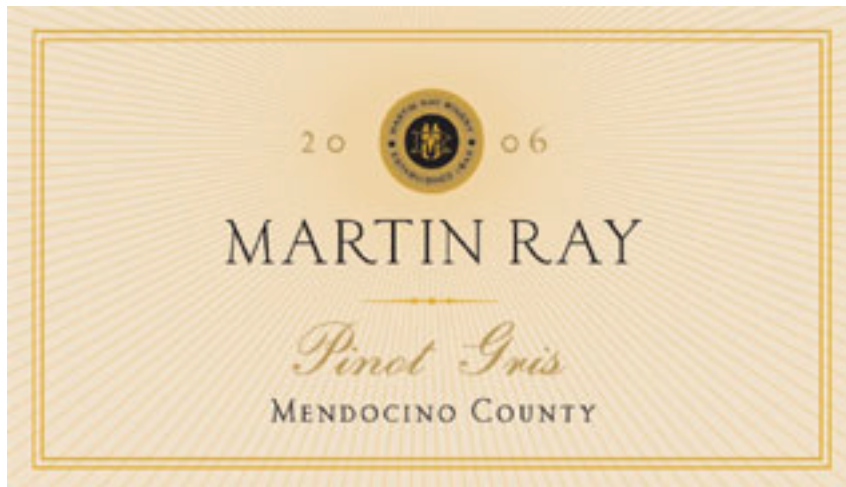




2006 Martin Ray Mendocino County Pinot Gris

“Opens with soft oak, lemon-lime and green apple. Flavors of lemon-lime and oak are touched with astringency and finish medium-broad and medium-long.”

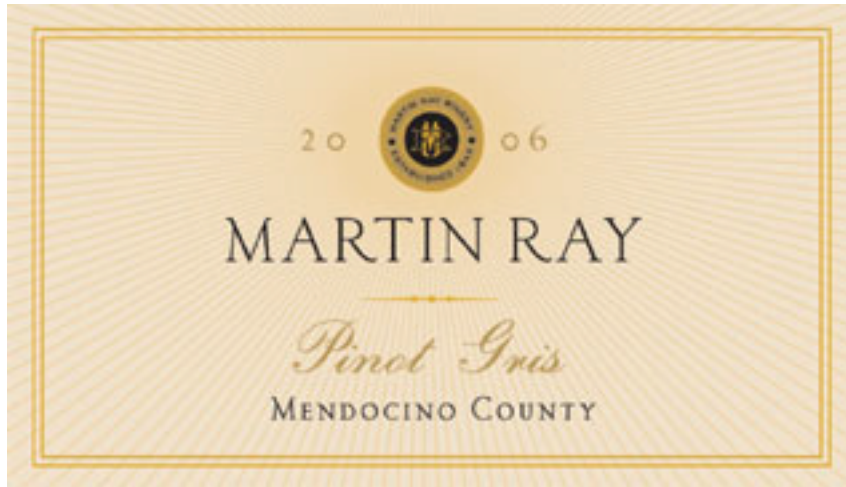
