2019 PINOT NOIR
CALIFORNIA

“Very pretty pinot with dried strawberries, flowers and cedar on the nose, following through to a medium to full body with a firm, silky-textured palate and a long, creamy finish. Attractive texture. Drink or hold. Screw cap.”



2019 RESERVE PINOT NOIR
MENDOCINO COUNTY

“Very pretty pinot with blue fruit, flowers and some orange peel. It’s medium-bodied with firm, silky tannins and a delicious finish. Bright acidity at the end. Drinkable now, but better after 2022. Screw cap.”



2019 RESERVE SAUVIGNON BLANC
SONOMA COUNTY

“A pleasant sauvignon with sliced-lemon and lime and some fennel character. Candied pear, too. Medium-bodied and fruity with a crisp finish. Drink now. Screw cap.”
