THE WINE

Cool-climate Sauvignon Blanc is defined by vibrant minerality and racy fruit profiles. Russian River has helped define this style, and our goal is to produce a refreshing wine with high acidity as an integral part of our portfolio.

SOURCING

Demple Vineyard, Mrs. George Vineyard (Dutton Ranch)

VINEYARD NOTES

Sourced from warm, sun-drenched vineyards in the central part of the valley, as well as cooler, foggy, clone-specific plots in the heart of Green Valley.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

100% Sauvignon Blanc

VINTAGE NOTES

Record setting rain and cooler temperatures lengthened dormancy, with first signs of budbreak mid-March. Hotter than average days in June and July brought harvest mid-August with lower than average yields across all varieties.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Hand-picked in 1/2 ton bins. Whole cluster pressed. Each separate lot was inoculated with a “bright-white” varietal specific yeast strain. Fermentation stopped immediately upon dryness.

TASTING NOTES

Notes of guava, ripe kiwi, and honeydew melon. Citrus notes of fresh lemon and lime zest. Juicy, clean body with tropical pineapple and subtle floral notes. Bright minerality and concise finish.
