Our Reserve Pinot Noir is the embodiment of all of our favorite characteristics from some of the most acclaimed Pinot Noir growing regions in the state. Floral and spicy aromatics from Mendocino County, and bright red fruit with integrated, soft tannins from the Russian River Valley and Carneros, come together to make this beautifully balanced Pinot Noir.

VINTAGE

Starting with rain during bloom, 2019 transitioned into a steady, slow to warm spring. Temperate throughout the summer, offering only a couple intermittent heat spikes. Average yields and incredible quality with harvest beginning in early August.

COMPOSITION

100% Pinot Noir

WINEMAKING

- Hand-picked
- Cold soaked and saigned to concentrate flavor and aromatics
- Average of 8-12 days fermenting at moderate temperatures
- 11 months, 30% new French oak barrels

TASTING NOTES

Crafted from hillside Mendocino County vineyards, our Pinot Noir offers notes of fresh black cherry, pomegranate, graphite and touches of vanilla, with subtle notes of wild mushroom and nutmeg.

PAIRING SUGGESTION

Plush and structured. Pairs perfectly with balsamic fig glazed pork roast.
