2020 CHARDONNAY CALIFORNIA

“Peaches, pears, melon rind, cooked lemons and cream on the nose. It’s full-bodied, soft and creamy. Easy finish. Drink now. Screw cap.”

POINTS

2020 PINOT NOIR CALIFORNIA

“A perfumed, floral nose of cherries, strawberries, cranberries, roses, chocolate orange and coconut. Medium body with fine tannins and lively acidity. Flavorful, crunchy finish. Drink now. Screw cap.”

POINTS

2020 RESERVE SAUVIGNON BLANC SONOMA COUNTY

“Dried pineapple, lemon, pear, cardamom, flint and blanched almond on the nose. It’s medium-to fullbodied with bright acidity. Mineral and subtly spicy. Drink now. Screw cap.”

POINTS

2020 RESERVE PINOT NOIR MENDOCINO COUNTY

“A concentrated pinot noir with aromas of dark berries, red plums, dried herbs, sweet tobacco and baking spices. Medium-bodied with crisp acidity and fine tannins. Sharp and crunchy with a spicy finish. Drink now or hold. Screw cap.”

POINTS

2020 PINOT NOIR RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

“Aromas of cherries, ripe raspberries, toasted bread and baking spices with mushroom undertones. Medium body with fine tannins and bright acidity. Lively and sharp on the palate with a fresh, dry finish. Drink now. Screw cap.”
