CHARDONNAY CONCRETE

With a deep appreciation for terroir-driven wines, we are continually committed to producing wines that are balanced and expressive, crafting each lot with care and detail. A true representation of cool-climate Chardonnay, its ripe concentration of fruit, intense acidity and minerality are dominant, framed by a weighty mid-palate.

TERROIR

With locations spanning the valley, each cool-climate site experiences its own distinct microclimate. Low-laying fog in the morning with ample sun exposure in the afternoon, and cool evening breezes help develop complex fruit profiles but maintain ample acidity.

THE WINE

To achieve a balance of ripe fruit and high acid, we use 476-gallon eggshaped concrete tanks from Sonoma Cast Stone. These tanks allow for continuous movement, keeping the lees in suspension, resulting in a more complex and fuller mouthfeel.
